Since West Creek Conservancy's inception we've worked to protect land and water resources throughout the West Creek watershed. The Village of Brooklyn Heights Park, which straddles the Village and the City of Seven Hills, is over 70 acres of conserved area with an amazing reach of West Creek. Over the past 23 years, West Creek Conservancy has partnered to protect & restore this unique area as well as link it into the overarching West Creek Greenway Trail System.

Explore the trail connections made here and learn about future connections to the West Creek Greenway! This hike is moderate terrain and approximately 3 miles.

Explore the future Irishtown Bend Park, a 23-acre area overlooking the Cuyahoga River and downtown skyline. The Port Authority of Cleveland, Cleveland Metroparks, LAND studio, Ohio City Inc., NEORSD, City of Cleveland, West Creek Conservancy and many others have been working together to stabilize and restore this vital reach of the Cuyahoga River and transform it into an amazing asset for all of Cleveland; also a future connection of the Cleveland Foundation Centennial Lake Link Trail.

The terrain for the hike is easy-moderate and the hike will be approximately 3 miles.

TREADWAY CREEK HIKE

June 5 | 10am

In 2003, the Cleveland Department of Parks, Recreation and Properties received a Clean Ohio Conservation Fund grant to help fund a critical greenway project to ensure conservation and access to the Treadway Creek ravine. West Creek Conservancy was brought in to hold a conservation easement enabling the project to move forward.

If you would like to experience how Treadway Creek Trail connects to the Towpath then join us for this spring hike! The hike will start in Harmody Park and travel down a portion of the Towpath Trail. The terrain is easy and the hike will be approximately 3.5 miles. The hike will be on paved, all-purpose trail. Meet near the trail head sign in the middle of the park.
