By including West Creek Conservancy in your estate planning you can ensure that you are remembered as someone whose enduring mission was to enrich the lives of future generations by:

- Conserving natural habitat
- Restoring the ecological value and sustainability of urban lands
- Expanding neighborhood opportunities to experience nature

BEQUESTS

Bequests from wills are the most common form of planned giving. You may, for example, specify a dollar amount or a percentage of your estate in your will. You can also name West Creek Conservancy as a beneficiary of a brokerage account or Certificate of Deposit.

LIFE INSURANCE

You can designate West Creek Conservancy as a beneficiary of an existing life insurance policy, or donate an older policy that you no longer need for your family's security. You can also purchase a new life insurance policy and transfer ownership to the Conservancy.

RETIREMENT ASSETS

Qualified retirement plans, such as an IRA, a 401(k), or a 403 (b), can be gifted to West Creek Conservancy. The proceeds of these plans are distributed outside probate and are free from federal estate tax.

REAL ESTATE GIFTS

There are two main types of property gifts. One is the gift of real estate, with or without buildings, given knowing that it can be sold to raise funds to support the work of the Conservancy.

The other type is real estate given with the agreement that it will be protected. By donating it to the Conservancy, you can ensure that the land is protected in perpetuity.

Donation agreements are flexible and can be tailored to suit your interests. Some donors may want to keep a "life interest" so that they have the right to remain on a donated property for the rest of their lives.
